


DOES YOUR REEL OFFER TOTAL CONTROL?

The latest is its TCA (Torsion Control Armor) technology. What does it mean?



A fishing reel is only so Taiwaness emanufacturer Okuma – which knows a thing or two about the subject having been making tackle including popular reels since 1986 – continues to design concepts and produce technology that helps improve these vital tools even further.

DOMINATE WITH POWER Okuma's TCA (Torsion Control Armor) offers maximum protection against the twists and turns which happen during casting and fighting fish, that can potentially weaken the body of a red.

The one-piece TCA design was built using Okuma C-40X carbon fibre technology and manufactured with a double arm design. Compared to traditional single side designs, TCAs double arm is said to offer higher torsion and flex resistance under heavy pressure for improved strength. This not

only makes the reel lighter but also extremely rigid, ensuring the internal parts stay in perfect alignment.

RESISTANCE UNDER PRESSURE


Pulling line through the roller and during retrieval increases pressure on your reel's body, creating numerous wear spots.

Okuma has tackled this issue thanks to its double arm TCA, which is understood to provide torsion resistance that is 25 per cent stronger than a traditional design.

STRENGTHENS AGAINST

WEAK POINTS
While traditional spinning
body designs utilised a singleside support, Torsion Control
Armor uses a durable doublearm design to help decrease
pressure on weak areas and
body twisting points.
